

Lorraine and Paul Gredvig Medical Scholarship

The Lorraine and Paul Gredvig Medical Scholarship consists of two \$500 awards given to students who are planning a career in the medical field, or medical-related field.

Students applying for the scholarship will need to complete the required application material on or before the deadline date. This scholarship will be awarded to the student after successfully completing his/her 1st semester as a full-time student at a 4-year accredited college, university, vocational school, or other accredited institution of higher education. In high school, applicants must have held a 2.5 GPA, and must have demonstrated high character, leadership skill, motivation, initiative, and respect for others.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

ALL APPLICATION MATERIALS MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE DEAN OF STUDENTS' OFFICE NO LATER THAN 4 P.M. ON APRIL 1st.

CRITERIA:

The applicant must:

- ✓ Plan to further his/her education at an accredited institution of higher education with a major in a medical or medical-related field
- ✓ Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher in high school
- ✓ Include two letters of reference (attach these to the application)
 - Name, profession and address of both references
- ✓ Include a copy of High School Transcript
- ✓ List of Activities (School and Community), Awards, Volunteer Activities, and Hobbies
- ✓ Include a one page essay titled "Why I have chosen to enter the medical field"
