*Congratulations to our class for earning another "Second Grade Teamwork" party last week. Students worked hard to be super listeners and direction followers! I am so proud of them!! We will celebrate this week with a nacho cheese/chips and movie party.

*This week students will learn about the importance of pedestrian safety, bike safety, and bus safety.

*Spelling word lists will be sent home on Mondays. The words will be tested on Fridays.

*This week we will start our 90 minute reading block each day. Students will work in small groups and rotate through various word work activities to boost literacy skills. The main part of each reading block includes BOOK CLUBS where students read in small groups with a group leader at their instructional level on phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension skills. Students are exposed to a variety of fiction and nonfiction books as well as different genres of books.

*In the "To Do" section of your child's take home folder is a weekly COLOR OF MY DAY paper. This allows your child to evaluate his or her daily behavior. Please be sure this paper is kept in his or her folder throughout the week. New sheets will be added at the beginning of each week.

HOMEWORK ~ Read 15-20 minutes each night to a person related to you.

Monday -

- *Students learned how to listen to each other tell about their weekend adventures and then wrote down their memories in journals.
- *Second graders became detectives as they searched to find the main idea and details of a passage.
- *Spelling words were introduced by students sorting one and two-syllable words and playing a game to review meanings of each.
- *Today in math we reviewed ALL of the concepts taught in Unit 1. Students should look over their Study Guide tonight as the format is very similar to the test students will be taking tomorrow.
- *Second graders read a Scholastic News article about germs on food.

HOMEWORK:

- *Spelling words send home (Unit 2). Please study the word list throughout the week. The spelling test will be on Friday. The homework sorting paper sent home tonight will also be due on Friday.
- *Math homework ~ Look over the Unit 1 Study Guide before tomorrow's test. No need to return the study guide to school.

Tuesday -

- *Students will edit and share their journal writing with friends.
- *During our reading mini-lesson second graders will become detectives as they search to find the main idea and details of a passage.
- *Students will blend sounds to read their spelling words and other words ending with a silent e.
- *Unit 1 Math Test
- *Second graders will continue to learn about plants during science.
